(as chanted on Wednesdays and Fridays during the Second through Sixth weeks of Great Lent)

Let my prayer a - rise in
thy sight as in - cense; and

The following verses are chanted by the priest; each is followed by the above refrain.

1. Lord, I have cried unto thee, hear me; attend to the voice of my supplication when I cry unto thee.
2. Set, O Lord, a watch before my mouth and a protecting door about my lips.
3. Incline not my heart to evil words; to make excuse in sins.
4. Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.
5. Both now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

PRIEST: Let my prayer arise in thy sight as incense;

CHOIR: and let the lifting up of my hands be an evening sacrifice.
